Dear partners,

USAID Developing Sustainable Tourism in Bosnia and Herzegovina (Turizam) and **the City of Mostar** are pleased to share with you new thematic itineraries and programs that link Mostar to the nearby towns, villages, and attractions that have been identified and selected as part of the **Mostar Hub and Spokes model**. These itineraries can be used to assist you in creating and developing new and attractive packages to attract more arrivals and increase the length of stay in the country using Mostar as the anchor destination (Hub) while encouraging excursions to nearby destinations (Spokes).

This innovative model aims at increasing the number of visitors, spending, and length of stay in Mostar and its satellite municipalities/cities located in its immediate vicinity within 1.5 hour's drive. **The Mostar Hub and Spokes model connects Mostar with 12 destinations** through a package of full-day or half-day offers/ itineraries, offering diverse trip and excursion options for regional and international travelers leading to the extended length of stay and increased per-visitor spending thus augmenting local economic benefits, new investments, and job creation.

The criteria for selecting the 12 Spokes include proximity to Mostar, infrastructural access, a plethora of cultural, historical, and natural attractions, unique experiences, accommodation facilities, the interest of the municipality/organization to partake, and based on that, a series of focus groups with relevant stakeholders were conducted to collect data on available attractions, experiences, and natural and cultural-historical assets.

Mostar Hub and Spokes destinations include: Neum, Ravno, Čitluk, Nevesinje, Široki Brijeg, Ljubuški, Grude, Stolac, and the neighboring municipalities of Berkovići, Ljubinje, Jablanica, and Konjic, as well as the wider area of the City of Mostar (Buna, Blagaj, Žitomislići, Goranci, etc.)

On the following pages, you can find a series of suggested thematic programs that suit different profiles of visitors and different interests. Depending on your needs and preference, those programs can be used as is, combined, or as an inspiration to develop additional ones.

Get lost in the flavors of the unique local cuisine and products, witness picturesque landscapes, and experience the life of local nomads, centuries-old traditions, and architecture.



Arrive back at Umoljani Village and prepare to go back to Mostar. Optionally, enjoy a wonderful dinner there before heading back.

The municipality of Čitluk is located in the southwestern region of Herzegovina. The area of today's Municipality of Čitluk, i.e. Brotnjo, was first mentioned in history in 1306/07. in trade relations with Dubrovnik. That date, the oldest so far, was found in the Dubrovnik Historical Archive, which points us to the fact that Brotnjo was connected to that coastal town back in the Middle Ages. Since the end of the fifties of the last century, the town of Čitluk has been developing as the administrative center of Brotnjo. Today, the Municipality of Čitluk (Brotnjo) is part of Herzegovina-Neretva Canton and covers an area of 181 km2. The municipality of Čitluk borders the cities: Mostar, Čapljina, Ljubuški and Široki Brijeg. Čitluk is one of the smallest municipalities in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is well-known for its agro products, autochthonous wines varieties, and history of tobacco production. It is said that almost every family in Čitluk has a vineyard.

Grude is a town and a municipality located in West Herzegovina Canton of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is situated on the edges of the fertile Imotsko-Bekija field, in Zabiokovlje. Jablanica With its 301 km² area, the municipality of Jablanica is one of the smallest municipalities in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The oldest excavations show that this area was inhabited as far back as the Metal Age, although it really flourished in the Roman era and in the Middle Ages, as evidenced by 42 sites with 683 necropolises with stećci. Most of these monuments of material culture originate from the end of the 2nd and the beginning of the 1st millennium BC, and the stećci mostly come from the late Middle Ages. The municipality has very good natural prerequisites for the development of tourism. Natural resources in the municipality of Jablanica are: Jablanica and Grabovičko lake, mountains Prenj and Čvrsnica, rivers Neretva, Doljanka and Šanica. The rivers Doljanka and Šanica are very interesting for fishing and camping in nature. Both of the mentioned mountains are over 2000 meters above sea level and as such represent a challenge to many mountaineers. There is a possibility of winter and summer tourism on the mentioned mountains.

Ljubuški is a city in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The town is located on the left side of the bank of Trebižat, a river on which there are numerous waterfalls, the most famous of which are Kravica and Koćuša. In addition to its natural beauty, Ljubuški is also known for its great cultural and historical heritage. In various localities, remains from almost every period of human history can be found. Ljubuški is located in the very west of Herzegovina along the border of the Republic of Croatia. Neum is a municipality in the south of Herzegovina. It is Bosnia and Herzegovina's only outlet to the Adriatic Sea. Neum is characterized by long and warm summers and short and mild winters, and is one of the coastal towns with the highest number of sunny days. Average monthly sea surface temperatures range from 13 °C in January to 32 °C in July and August. Favorable climatic conditions make it possible, in addition to swimming and sunbathing, for almost 7 months a year for climate therapy, which consists of clean coastal air, walks along the coast and various water sports. The mild Mediterranean climate in this area favors the cultivation of the following: tobacco, figs, vines, almonds, laurel, cabbage, potatoes and onions. Several types of cheese, wine, brandy from vines and herbs, dried and salted fish, prosciutto, dried figs, honey and woolen products are also produced.

Nevesinje

Nevesinje lies on the western outskirts of Nevesinje field, at the foot of the steep Grebak pass. It is 36 km from Mostar, and since 1973 it has been connected to it by the main road. The municipality of Nevesinje is a Dinaric area with an average altitude of 860 meters. It is located for the most part in Nevesinje polje, the total area of which is 18 thousand hectares. The Zalomka sinkhole flows through the field. There are two mountains on the territory of the municipality, Velež on the northwest side and Crvanj on the northeast. To the east is the vast Morine plateau. Nevesinje field has been a very important traffic area since prehistoric times, through antiquity and the Middle Ages, due to the impossibility of passing through the Neretva canyon from Konjic to Salakovac (north of Mostar).



Stolac is a town located in the southeastern part of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in the extreme east of Herzegovina-Neretva Canton. The town was built on the banks of the karst beauty of the Bregava river, which surrounds the Hrgud mountains and Vidovo polje. On the western side is the Dubrava plateau, which is specific and known for its peaches and, above all, the Dubrava vineyard for which Stolac's wines are known. The Stolac area has attracted people since prehistoric times with its Mediterranean charm, good water, mild skies, gentle landscape and harmony of natural beauty. Illyrians and Greek sailors, Roman patricians, Eastern Gothic and Ottoman conquerors, Slavic dignitaries, Venetian military leaders, Austro-Hungarian governors, and many admirers of the sun, the freshness of the Bregava River, cultural and historical landmarks and secret messages from the past centuries, left their mark there. Stolac is an area with the longest and most luxurious history of life in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and belongs to a small group of those areas where material evidence of urban forms of life has been preserved for a period of over 3,500 years, which is how old the last known finds of the Illyrian town of Daorson, which they also call their ages Mikena of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The continuity of the presence of the human community in the area of Stolac goes back 16,000 years.

Široki Brijeg is located on the river Lištica. The area of the city is 388 km². The city center is located at 270 meters above sea level, so it belongs to the part called "low Herzegovina", although a large part of the municipality belongs to the so-called "High Herzegovina" (almost the entire northern part of the town). The wider area of Široki Brijeg is located on characteristic very complex structural forms which, in geotectonic terms, belong to the so-called Zones of high karst. The main characteristic of the area is the limestone rocks, which are characterized by various karst forms (sinks, pits, sinkholes, karst fields, etc.) and deeply cut valleys. The town of Široki Brijeg is located on the edge of the Mediterranean climate spreading towards the area with a continental climate. Long and dry summers are characteristic, and winters are short and abundant with precipitation.
